

MARY G'S DRESS CODE POLICY

AT ALL TIMES

- Neat casual dress code
- Footwear is to be worn at all times. No dirty or damaged footwear is permitted
- No hats/caps or beanies
- No indecent clothing, no obscene or offensive prints
- No clothing that condones violence (e.g. Tapout brand)
- No gang/motorcycle club clothing
- No face covering clothing (unless agreed by the manager)
- No offensive bodily odours
- No unkempt hair/rats tails
- All bags brought into the Venue may be subject to search prior to entering the Venue. However, patrons are free to refuse the bag search and enter the Venue without the questionable bag

AFTER 9PM

All of the above with the addition of:

- No singlets, muscle shirts or sleeveless shirts on gentlemen
- No tracksuit pants/tops
- No hooded jumpers
- No sports uniform (exception – sports themed events at the Hotel)
- No thongs (women may wear open shoes if the appearance is neat and tidy as a minimum)
- No joggers
- No perforated jackets
- No quick dry shorts material
- Dress shorts are acceptable and must be of neat and tidy appearance (subject to management)

If in doubt, call the Hotel and speak to the manager.

MARY G'S CODE OF CONDUCT

- You will be refused entry or required to leave the premises if you are:
- Intoxicated or approaching intoxication
- Offensive, loud, quarrelsome, or abusive to other customers, staff or management
- Inappropriately attired
- Have been previously barred
- Drinking alcohol in the streets/public area prior to entry
- Patrons are also advised to carry valid photo ID with them whilst on the premises and the Venue is unable to accept any expired or damaged ID.

This Hotel Policy is enforced for the safety of all our patrons. Patrons refusing to leave when asked will be charged with a "Failure to quit a licensed premise" and fined.

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
